Composite wood products (resins/plastics/polymers mixed with wood product):

Trex (decking and deck components made primarily with recycled plastic grocery bags, reclaimed pallet wrap and waste wood) www.trex.com

Tendura (decking made from recycled plastic where possible and by-product sawdust. Non-leaching – nothing filters out of it into groundwater. Longer life than traditional timber.) <http://www.tendura.com>

Firestall decking, a board made from layers of Homasote, a recycled newspaper product. Unlike regular plywood, Firestall contains no formaldehyde (beyond what may be in the newsprint ink) and is rated for structural use as a roof-decking material. Homasote (recycled newsprint with following characteristics/uses: Structural, House-Healthy, Insulating, Sound Deadening, Tackable, Concrete Forming, Roof Decking, Panels, Packaging Solutions) www.homasote.com

Oriented Strand Board (OSB, “chipboard”, “wafer-board” – veneers or thin chips of wood oriented for maximum strength, structurally efficient, contain formaldehyde, however. Exterior-rated glues, counter-intuitively, contain the less-volatile phenol-formaldehyde, while interior-rated glues contain urea-formaldehyde.) wherever wood is sold
